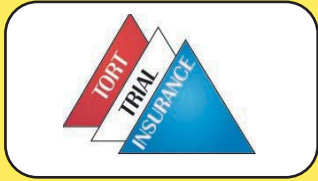


# The American Bar Association's Tort Trial & Insurance Practice Section (TIPS) & The American Insurance Association (AIA) Joint Program
